Let me tell you about our parades:

1. Parade route is of **“Loop” Design**. You start and end close to your buses.
2. **Convenient Parking** - adjacent to Buckwheat Festival Fair Grounds.
3. **Excellent Carnival, Exhibits, and Attractions** for your entertainment.
4. **Refreshments and Food** conveniently available.
5. **Financial Help** – We pay **\$1.00** per mile (round trip mileage) per bus/truck for transportation. (Minimum of **\$100.00** per bus)
6. **Large Trophies** – Presented after parades to the first place bands in each division.
7. **Professional Judges**
8. Choice of **Three Parades** – you can attend any or all three.

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Dear Band Director;

We are looking forward to the participation of your band in the 80th Annual Preston County Buckwheat Festival held in Kingwood, West Virginia on **September 29, 30, October 1, 2022.**

A map of Kingwood is enclosed for your convenience. Your attention is directed to the following points on the map:

- **School Bus Parking** on South Price Street. This is located convenient to the line-up area, end of parade, and refreshment stand/carnival grounds. **All band students need to be chaperoned in the bus parking area.**
- **Bands Line Up Area** on Morgan Street. A Parade Marshal will be available at the head of Morgan Street for your assistance. Restrooms will also be located in this area. (Porta-Johns)
- **Parade Route** is marked on your map. The parade route on Thursday will be approximately .7 mile and on Friday and Saturday will be .9 mile.
- **Band Judging** will occur on Main Street. There is a crosswalk in front of the old WesBanco Bank building. This designates the beginning of the judging area. Please make certain your band plays in front of the Judges' Stand. There is a severe point penalty for not doing so.
- **Reviewing Stand** is located on Brown Avenue in front of the Community Building. Be sure to play here. Your band will not be adjudicated in this area, but you cannot find a more appreciative audience.

Here are some other tips which will facilitate your trip and enhance your band's appearance:

- Please allow ample time for buses to enter town and park. Traffic congestion is the usual thing at the Buckwheat Festival.
- The bands will be adjudicated by professional judges.
- Trophies and score sheets will be available at the Festival Information Booth approximately 45 minutes after completion of the parade. A composite report with scores of all **COMPETITIVE BANDS**, will be given to each Band Director.
- We have had problems with some bands holding up the parade in past years. **Any band stopping for alignment purposes on Main Street or otherwise holding up the parade or not marching to designated end of parade route (past Kingwood Elementary), will be disqualified from the competition.**

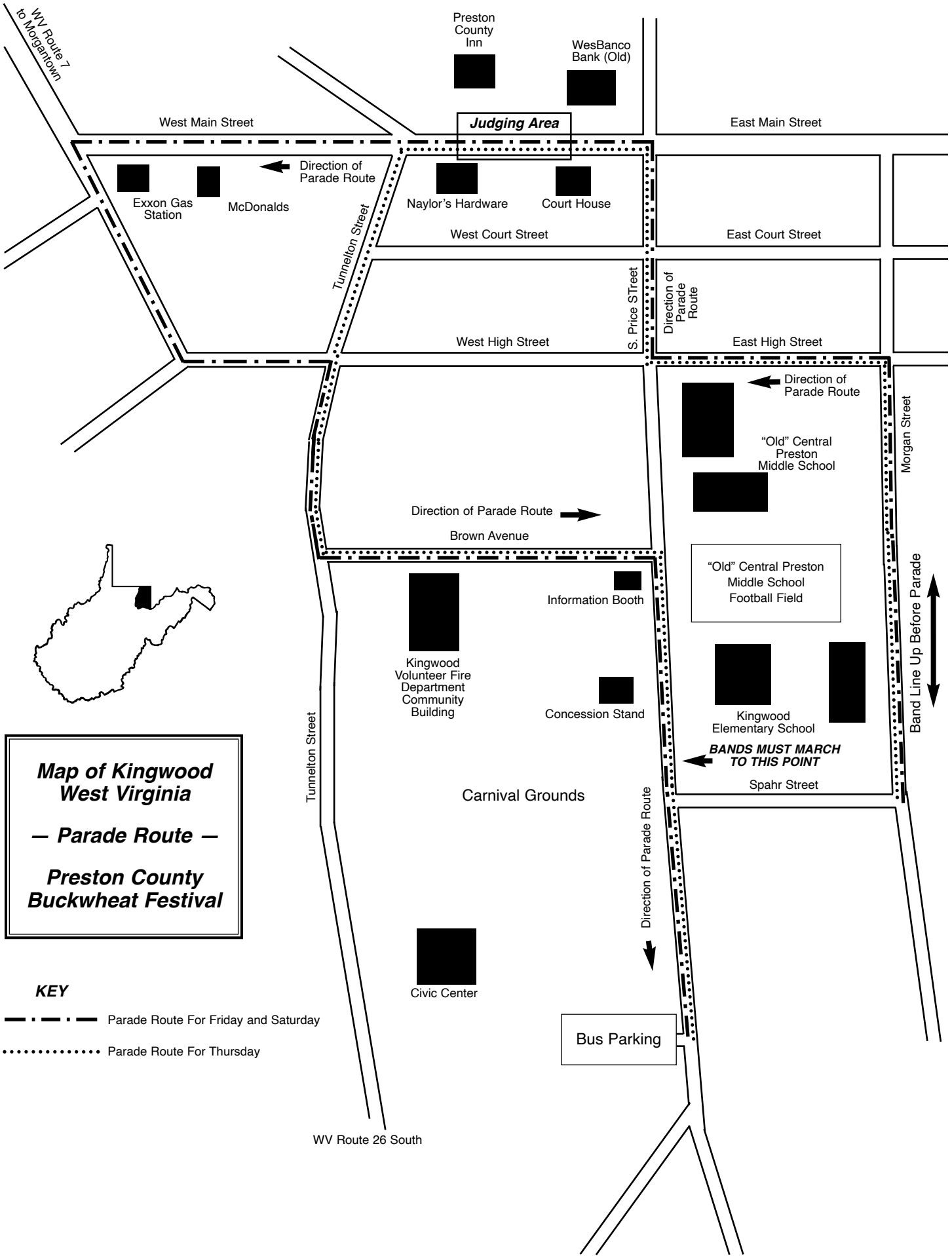
